Upholding human life from the very start

Why human embryos matter

Human embryos matter because they are like us. They are members of the human family. They are small – but that doesn't make them less human. They are made up of cells - so are we. It is wrong to kill them.

Embryos 'matter' to the biotech industry because they want to use living human beings for experiments. One line of research is to use embryos as a source of stem cells. But the embryos are killed in the process. No treatment or cure for any disease has yet been developed by human embryo research, despite killing millions of embryos. Other medical research, such as using stem cells from adults, has produced many advances.

The Human Fertilisation and Embryology Bill is designed to increase experiments on these vulnerable embryos. It will also extend experiments such as making cloned embryos and animal-human hybrids. Please ask your MP to oppose the bill and support ethical research instead. In addition, a child's need for a father will not be recognised for test-tube babies under this bill.

More abortions

Within the same bill, pro-abortion MPs want to widen the law on abortion. This would mean more abortions and there are already 500-600 abortions every day. They want to impose the Abortion Act on Northern Ireland, despite strong objections there.
