**ABORTION**

Abortion is only legal in this country if the criteria of the 1967 Abortion Act are met. If the criteria are not met abortion remains a criminal offence under sections 58 and 59 of the 1861 Offences Against the Person Act. Pro-abortion campaigners want to repeal the 1861 Act to permit abortion for any reason, at any time and without any involvement of a doctor. Women could put their mental and physical health at risk buying abortion pills online or from a pharmacist.
